

# Marijuana Legislation in Michigan

There are 3 Marijuana Acts that are currently law

## 2008 Michigan Medical Marihuana Act

- Allows for patient/caregiver relationship for medical marihuana
- Patients may possess up to 12 plants and 2.5 ounces of marihuana
- Caregivers may register to serve up to 5 patients
- Patients/caregivers must be registered with the state registry programs
- may not sell marihuana

## 2016 Medical Marihuana Facilities Licensing Act

- Allows for commercial sale of marihuana to patients and caregivers
- 5 different types of licenses granted by the Medical Marihuana Licensing Board: growers, processors, provisioning centers, secure transporters, safety compliance facilities.
- May not sell marihuana to non-cardholders

## 2018 Michigan Regulation and Taxation of Marihuana Act

- Up to 12 plants per household and 10 oz. Amounts greater than 2.5 oz must be locked in a safe
- Up to 2.5 oz on your person, no more than 15 grams of marihuana concentrates
- Allows for commercial sale of marihuana to adults over the age of 21.
- 6 types of licenses granted by the Bureau of Marihuana Licensing: growers, processors, retailers, microbusinesses, secure transporters, safety compliance facilities.
